The **Master of Architecture in Collective Housing, MCH**, is a postgraduate full-time international professional program of advanced architecture design in cities and housing presented by **Universidad Politécnica of Madrid (UPM)** and **Swiss Federal Institute of Technology of Zurich (ETH)**. After ten editions, it is rated as one of the best architecture master's programs by architects and experts.

MCH is the first UPM-ETH postgraduate program. It takes place mainly in Madrid, official language is English.

Next edition will start in January 2019, application period is opened till 31.12.2018.
